Valley Parent Preschool 2023-24 Covid-19 FAQ

We know there are many questions about Covid-19 and how Valley Parent Preschool is approaching preschool during the pandemic. Given the unpredictable nature of the situation, it is not possible for us to know exactly what things will look like next school year, but below is what we do know at this time. Our school remains flexible and committed to the health, safety, and wellness of our community and we have been incredibly grateful for our school families who share this vision and have joined us in providing a safe place for children and families to learn and grow.

Will Covid vaccines be required for staff and volunteers?

Covid Vaccines will be recommended but not required for all adults and children on campus. We will continue to follow the guidelines set forth by the state, county, and Community Care licensing with regards to covid vaccine requirements. VPP asks that co-oping adults declining the COVID vaccine wear a mask indoors at VPP.

Will Covid boosters be required for staff and volunteers?

We highly recommend but don't require all adults on campus to keep current on their Covid-19 booster shots.

Will Covid vaccines be required for children?

We do not plan to require children be vaccinated against Covid-19 unless the state or county requires it. If or when it becomes a requirement, we will follow suit.

Could some policies be different based on children's vaccination status?

Yes, school policies including, but not limited to travel, quarantine, and masking could be different depending on a child's vaccination status.

Will masks be required?

We will be meeting, but not exceeding, local and state masking requirements. VPP asks that co-oping adults declining the COVID vaccine wear a mask indoors at VPP.

Are tuition or registration fees refundable if my comfort level with the pandemic or Covid-19 policies change?

Enrollment fees and tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable for any reason. The <u>General Information Policy</u> and <u>Handbook</u> may be found here. Families are asked to read everything thoroughly before enrolling to be sure VPP is a good fit for your family.
